Courses Offered:

- **BEGINNING FLYCASTING:** The basics — how to roll cast, pickup and lay down line. *(Due to its popularity last year, two Beginning Level classes will offered each session.)*
- **CONTROL and PRESENTATION:** Improve loop control, accuracy and roll casting.
- **INTERMEDIATE CLASS:** Introduction to accuracy casting, shooting line and casting in the wind.
- **PRIVATE INSTRUCTION:** Two students per instructor. \$100 per person for 2 hours. Learn whatever you want to learn about flycasting, freshwater or saltwater. *(Limited to four students for each morning and afternoon session.)*
- **SPEY CASTING:** Introduction to the two-handed rod and casting techniques. Spey equipment will be available for use. *(This class is held on the river. Students need to bring waders and boots. Progression of skills will be individualized for each student's needs. Students may register for both spey sessions, if desired.)*
